Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 / May 1

After your arrival at the airport, you will be transferred to the hotel. You will have free time to relax after registration at the hotel. Also, you will have lunch in a traditional restaurant. The tour will start with an excursion around the ancient capital of Armenia, Yerevan, where history and modernity are interwoven harmoniously. You will visit Victory Park and enjoy the view of the whole city. Then, tour direction turns to the extraordinary open-air museum of arts as well as a favorite place, called Cascade. Finally, walking along the main street, Mashtots Avenue, you can see the building of Opera and Ballet Theater, Republic Square and several central streets of Yerevan.

Day 2 / May 2

The day will start with a trip to the scenic gorge of the River Azat. Here you will visit the XIII century caved Monastery Geghard, which is on the World Heritage List of UNESCO. The monastery is partly carved out of a rock and built with local basalt stones. In Geghard, the spear of Longinus has been kept for many centuries. Next, you will visit the Hellenistic Garni Temple located in the village of Garni close to the Geghard Monastery. Here you will have lunch in the backyard of a local resident's house. Later national bread lavash baking will be demonstrated. The tour will continue to Lake Sevan, one of the greatest mountainous freshwater lakes in the world, it is located at 2000 m above sea level. Here you will go to the peninsula for admiring the breathtaking view of ultramarine Sevan Lake surrounded by mountains. Also, you will visit the IX century monastery Sevanavank. Further, in the evening you will participate in Yerevan Wine Festival.

Overnight: Hotel in Yerevan Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3 / May 3

After breakfast, you will communicate with the heritage of all humanity in Matenadaran. Here are kept the very first books and the Bible which were created throughout typography. Afterwards, you will go to the gorge of Kasakh River and have an incredible view of the canyon as soon as you reach the monastery. On the way, you will stop at the Armenian alphabet monument located in Byurakan, which was opened in 2005 in honour of the 1600th anniversary of alphabet bases. Then, you will go to the slopes of Mount Aragats, wherein the tavern of Amberd restaurant you will have a masterclass of cooking a national Armenian dish, Khashlama. After lunch, you will go to Amberd Fortress.

Overnight: Hotel in Yerevan Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 4 / May 4

The tour will continue through Ararat Valley and lead to Khor Virap Monastery, which history is associated with the adoption of Christianity in Armenia. As Khor Virap is close to the mountain, you can enjoy an amazing view of Mount Ararat. Later you will visit the-13th-century monastery Noravank located in the indescribable beautiful gorge among the red rocks. The next stop is Areni village situated in the heart of Vayots Dzor Province, which is the major winemaking region in Armenia. The famous grapes of "Areni" soaked in the sun are grown here, as well as you will degustate variety of wines in the local factory. Here



in the local tavern, you will have a wonderful lunch and wine. At the end of the tour, you will return to Yerevan.

Overnight: Hotel in Yerevan Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 5 / May 5

This is a free day for you to enjoy Yerevan fully. We advise you to have a walk in the city, visit numerous museums, souvenir shops, food market and Vernissage known for its amazing national handmade souvenirs and paintings. In the evening, you will have a gala farewell dinner in a traditional restaurant.

Day 6 / May 6

Transfer to the airport, departure.



Booking terms and conditions

Please, note that the prepayment (50-100 euros) is non-refundable, however, you can use it throughout the year and book another tour. In this case, our company will have to charge an extra 100 euros for re-booking the hotel.

Rights and obligations

Tours provided by our company are planned for many months before its inception and are not the subject of change or cancellation. Under the obligation of forced circumstances (weather, holidays) we can make some changes in the itinerary, however, all that relates to services and attractions will remain unchanged. Please note, that our tours require a minimum number of participants – 2 persons. We reserve the right to cancel the trip, if any tour will not have the minimum number of participants. We will inform you about the cancellation of the tour no later than 30 days before the start and will do the full refund of the amount paid, including the prepayment.

We also request immediately and promptly report all complaints and any claims during the tour. If possible, all problems will be solved. If the tourist does not report any complaint, the compensation will not be implemented.

Please, also note that the company Arara Tour is not liable for services not included in the tour price. Our responsibility is limited only to the extent provided by our tour.
